










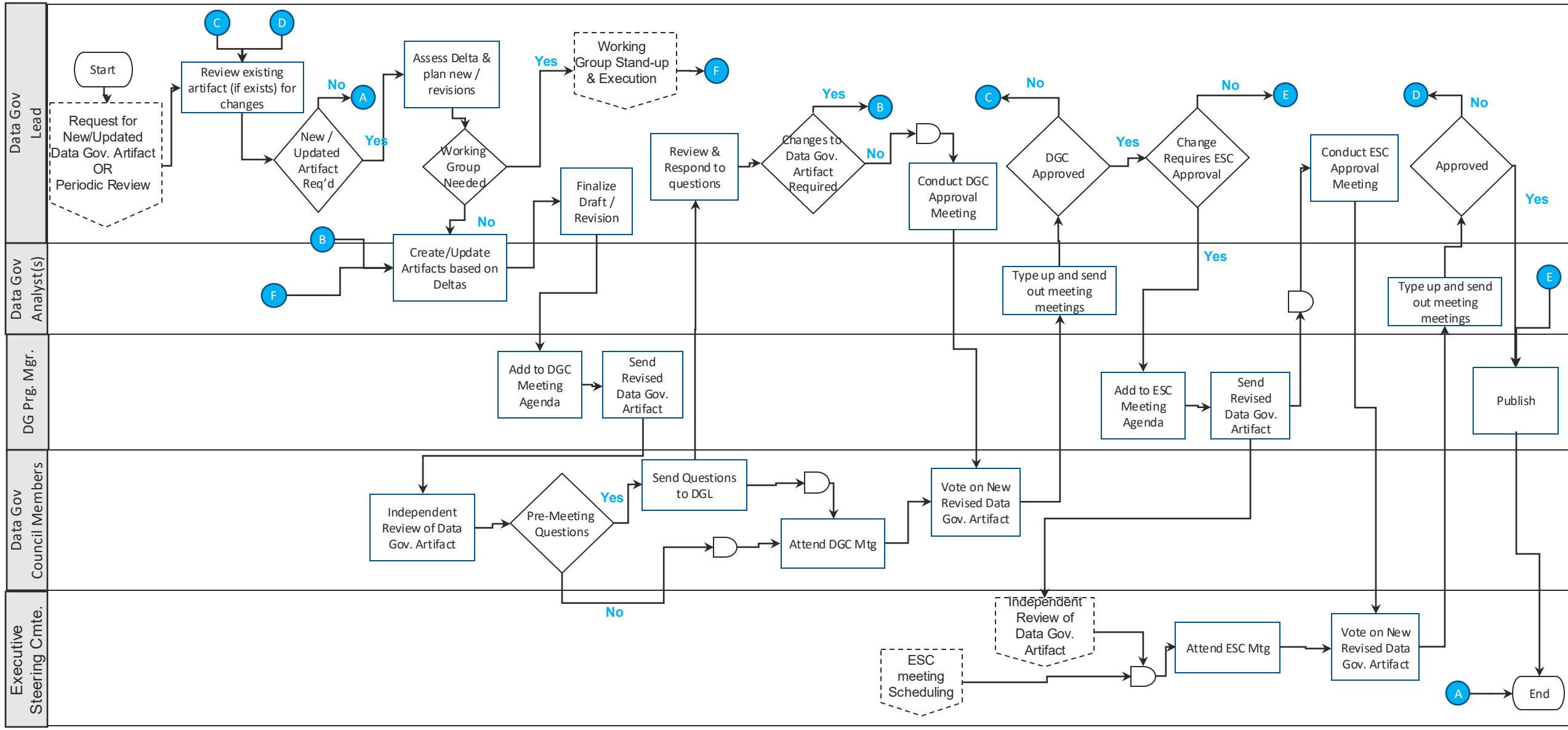


Process Flow: Key Symbols

Shape	Meaning
	Swim lane: represents who (org, person, system) is performing the action, regardless of what system the action is being performed in
	Process Step / activity within the process flow
	Decision that is being made within the process flow
	Process activity flow
	On-page connector: process continues on another part of the same slide
	Off-page connector: represents a part of the process or a separate process that is documented on a separate slide (name in shape should match name on additional slide)
	Off-page connector: process continues, but not documented
	Delay: demonstrates a delay introduced into the process, so that the process steps/activities are not immediately one after the other
	Start: shows where the process initiates End: shows where the process terminates
	Process Note: Details will be found on the corresponding Notes slide
	Pain Point: Details will be found on the corresponding Notes slide
